floor **Accessories**

Complete range of finishing accessories that come in matching colors with our floors which add a decorative touch and give the floors a professionally finished look.



Reducer profiles are commonly used along the doors where two different floors meet each other. These are also used for transition between two floors that are not level with each other.

T-Profile is a transitional profile that connects two floors which are at the same level. These are essential where the maximum run length of the floor exceeds 10m, and along doors where two different floors meet each other.





Quarter Round Beedings are used to blend the flooring with Cabinets or Glass partitions and to cover the Expansion gap and give the floor a refind look along such fixtures.

Skirtings add a decorative touch and give the floor a professionally finished look. These are used around the edges of the floor, along the walls to cover the expansion gap and to nicely blend the flooring with walls.







Installation Instructions

Suitable Floors

Level Solid Floors, Well Cured concrete, Marble and Ceramic Subfloors. All surfaces must be Clean, Even, Dry and Dust free

Unsuitable Floors

Rough, uneven, textured or unleveled surfaces or subfloors. Such surfaces may result in improper installation and cause damage to the floor planks & shall void warranty. Do not install this product in areas which are damp or prone to moisture and termites, exposed to long term sunlight. #For Indoor application Only.

Installer / Owner Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the Installer & the owner to ensure that job site environment & sub-floor conditions meet all requirements as mentioned in these installation instructions. Manufacturer declines any or all responsibility for product performance or installation issues due to sub-floor deficiencies or jobsite conditions. **Note:** All work involving plumbing, masonry, painting, plastering, etc must be completed prior to flooring installation. Measures should be taken to protect floors from other trade works to avoid surface abrasion & scratches.

Preparation

Carefully check that all cartons have the same Model and Batch Number and that you have purchased sufficient material to complete the job. Manufacturer reserves the right to discontinue any model without prior notice and additional material might not be available in some cases. Open each carton and carefully check all planks prior to installation. Any plank that has been installed will be deemed acceptable to the installer. New concrete floors need to dry out for at least 15 days prior to installation. Scrape, plane or fill uneven holes or cracks using floor-leveling compound to skim coat grout lines. Remove any traces of dirt, grime or residue from the surface and ensure that the surface is smooth, clean, dry and level. The maximum run length is 9.14m (30ft.). For areas beyond 9.14m(30ft), the floor will require transition strips. Note: This product requires an underlay preferably an IXPE or EVA sheet with 2mm thickness. Place the underlay from edge to edge, making sure that it covers the entire area of application prior to installation. # Do not install this product without an underlay.

Diagram 1: Remove the tongues (on the long side) for the first row of planks on the long side. This will ensure that the decorative surface of the flooring is under the skirting when installed. Start in a corner by placing the first plank with the trimmed side facing the wall. Use spacers along each wall to maintain an expansion gap of 8mm between the wall and the flooring. **Note: This product needs space for expansion and contraction and thus this spacing must also be maintained between the floor and all vertical surfaces, including cabinets, posts, partitions, door jams and door tracks.** You will also need to use transition strips in doorways and between rooms. Failure to do so may cause buckling or gaping.

Diagram 2: To attach your second plank, lower and lock the end tongue of the second plank into the end groove of the first plank. Line up edges carefully to ensure a close and tight fit. Using a rubber mallet, lightly tap the top of the end joints where the first and second planks lock together. The planks should lay flat to the floor. Repeat this procedure for each subsequent plank in the first row. Continue the first row until you reach the last full plank.

Diagram 3: To install the last plank of the first row, fit the last plank by rotating the plank 180° with the pattern side upward and placing it beside the first row of planks with its end up against the far wall. Line a ruler up across the end of the last full plank and across the new plank. Draw a line across the new plank with a pencil, and cut off the plank using a saw. Now rotate the cut plank 180°, so that it is back to its original orientation. Lower and lock its end tongue into the end grove of the last full plank. Lightly tap the top of the end joints with a rubber mallet until the planks are flat on the floor. You will begin the next row with the cut off piece from the first row to stagger the pattern. Pieces should be a minimum of 200mm(8 in) long and joint offset should be at least 400mm (16 in). Cut pieces should be no less than 152.4mm(6 in) in length and 76.2mm (3 in) in width. Adjust for a balanced look.


Diagram 4: To start your second row, rotate the cut off piece from the previous row 180° so that it is back to its original orientation. Tilt and push its side tongue into the side groove of the very first plank. When lowered, the plank will click into place. Using a tapping block and rubber mallet, lightly tap the long side of the new plank to lock it with the planks of the first row. The planks should lay flat to the floor.

Diagram 5: Attach the second plank of the new row first on the long side. Tilt and push into place, making sure edges are lined up. Lower plank to the floor. using a tapping block & rubber mallet, lightly tap the long side of the new plank to lock it into place. Next, lightly tap down on top of the end joints with a rubber mallet to lock them together. Continue laying remaining planks in this manner.

Diagram 6: To fit the plank of the last row, lay a plank on top of the previous row with the tongue to the wall. Lay a ruler across the plank so that it is lined up with the side of the planks of the previous row and draw a line across the new plank with a pencil. Don't forget to allow room for spacers. Cut the plank with the hand saw and attach into position as done before.

Diagram 7: Door frames and heating vents also require expansion room. First cut the plank to the correct length. Then Place the cut plank next to its actual position and use a ruler to measure the areas to be cut out and mark them. Cut out the marked points allowing the necessary expansion distance on each side.

Diagram 8: You can trim for door frames by turning a plank upside down and using a handsaw to cut away the necessary height so that planks slide easily under the frames. Remove the spacers once the floor is completely installed.





Care & Maintenance





Laminate floors may look like wood, But you can't just treat them like seasoned wood. Cleaning laminate floors requires a focused approach and less water than you might think!

- For General everyday cleaning, use a soft-bristle broom to sweep and collect dust.
- Occasionally clean the floor using a dampened micro fibre cloth/mop, once or twice a month. Do not soak the floor with water. Though laminate floors are water resistant, if they are soaked in water, they can be damaged.
- For deep cleaning, the best way is to use products made especially for them such a laminate floor cleaner. If you don't have them, a teaspoon of baby shampoo in 10 Litre of water will also work. Use the solution to clean the floor and immediately dry it using a micro fibre cloth/mop. Be careful not to soak the floor. Deep cleaning should only be done once or twice a year.
- Avoid oil-based cleaners and products designed for wood products and furniture. They can leave streaks that are impossible to remove. Never wax or polish your laminate flooring.
- Wipe all spills immediately and never allow any liquid to sit on the surface for longer periods. Blot spills with a microfibre cloth or tissue as soon as they happen.
- If wax or gum falls on your floor, freeze it with an ice pack. Then, carefully scrape up the frozen wax or gum with a plastic scraper or plastic knife. Wipe the area with a lightly dampened microfiber cloth to pick up any residue.
- Oily spots or colour stains, like marker, lipstick or ink, can be treated with mild acetone or nail polish remover. Place a small amount of the liquid on a clean cloth and wipe up the stain. Follow with a lightly dampened microfiber cloth to pick up anything that's left. Be sure the area is dry to the touch when you finish.
- Never use a floor buffer or polisher while cleaning laminate flooring
- Don't use abrasive or acidic cleaners. Harsh cleaners might strip the protective coating from the floor.
- Don't use steel wool or scouring powder. Both can leave scratches on your floor.
- Never try to slide anything heavy across the floor. Use protective pads under all furniture.
- Place entry mats at doorways to keep dirt and grime from being tracked onto the floor.
- To prevent scratches, keep your pet's nails trimmed.


