





Reducer profiles are commonly used along the doors where two different floors meet each other. These are also used for transition between two floors that are not level with each other.

T-Profile is a transitional profile that connects two floors which are at the same level. These are essential where the maximum run length of the floor exceeds 10m, and along doors where two different floors meet each other.





Quarter Round Beedings are used to blend the flooring with Cabinets or Glass partitions and to cover the Expansion gap and give the floor a refind look along such fixtures.

Skirtings add a decorative touch and give the floor a professionally finished look. These are used around the edges of the floor, along the walls to cover the expansion gap and to nicely blend the flooring with walls.

IMPORTANT INTRUCTIONS

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE INSTALLATION

SUITABLE AREAS OF APPLICATION

Level solid floors, well cured concrete, Marble, Tile and Ceramic Subfloors. Raised access flooring with plywood on top. All surfaces must be level, smooth, dry, even and dust free.

For Indoor use only.

UNSUITABLE AREAS OF APPLICATION

Rough, uneven, heavily textured and unleveled surfaces or subfloors. Such surfaces may result in improper installation and cause damage to floor planks and shall void warranty. Do not install this product in areas which are exposed to long term sunlight & areas that are continuously wet such as shower cubicals, saunas and steam rooms, etc. Do not install this product with under floor heating system. Not for Outdoor Application.

PRE-INSTALLATION SUBFLOOR REQUIREMENTS

- Sub Floor must be 100% Level, smooth, completely dry, clean, and free all foreign material such as dust, wax, solvents, paint, grease, oils, and old adhesive residue. The surface must be hard and dense, and free from powder or flaking.
- New concrete floors must dry at least 3 days prior to installation. Maximum moisture level per CaCl test method is 5 lbs per 1000 in 24 hrs.
- Do no install over concrete with a history of high moisture or hydrostatic conditions.
- Flooring should be the last item to be installed in any new construction or renovation project.
- Polythene underlay to be used and must cover 100% of the installation area prior to installation.

INSTALLER / OWNER RESPONSIBILITY

- It is the responsibility of the Installer and the owner to ensure that subfloor conditions and job site
 environment meet all requirements as mentioned in suitable and unsuitable areas of application prior to
 installation. Manufacturer declines any or all responsibility/warranty for product performance or
 installation issues due to sub-floor and environmental deficiencies or jobsite conditions.
- All other trade works such as masonry, plumbing, carpentry, electrical and painting, etc must be completed prior to installation as they can cause damage to your new floor. Incase it is absolutely necessary to carry out such trade works after the flooring has been installed, the flooring must be properly protected using thick covers from edge to edge to avoid any abrasion or scratches.
- Carefully check that all cartons have the same Model & Batch Number and that you have purchased sufficient material to complete the job. Manufacturer reserves the right to discontinue any model without prior notice and additional material might not be available in some cases.
- Open each carton and carefully check all planks prior to installation. Any Plank that has been installed will be deemed acceptable to the installer.

Installation must be strictly carried out according to the installation instructions provided herein. Manufacturer declines any or all responsibility/warranty for product performance due to improper installation.

INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

STARTING YOUR INSTALLATION


• Since polymers, expand and contract, an 8mm expansion gap between the perimeter walls, fixtures and any other adjacent floor must be maintained at all times.

Note: Larger rooms require additional expansion space and transition profiles after every 10 meters in length.


- Floating installations require an underlayment of polythene. It must cover the entire area of application.
- Work from several open boxes of flooring and "dry lay" the floor before permanently laying the floor.
 This will allow you to select varying textures, colors, and sheens, and to arrange them in a harmonious
 pattern. Remember, it is the installer's responsibility to determine the expectations of what the finished
 floor will look like with the end user first and then to cull out pieces that do not meet those expectations.




Step 1: Begin installation from left to right. Insert spacers at the ends where planks meet the wall to maintain an 8mm expansion gap.




Step 2: Lock short end of plank by inserting tongue into groove at an angle and drop in place. Continue laying planks to end of first row.




Step 3: Use leftover plank from first row as starter for second row. Keep a Minimum of 8 Inchs distance between plank end joints for a staggered look.




Step 4: Lock long side of plank by inserting tongue into groove at an angle & drop in place. Slide plank towards end of the previous plank until the tongue just touches the groove.




Step 5: Use hammer and tapping block to engage plank and ensure tight fit.




Step 6: Attach a scrap piece to align planks and bridge gaps between planks.



Step 7: Tap end of planks with hammer & tapping block to engage ends.



Step 8: Use hammer and a pull bar to engage final piece, insert spacers and continue to next row.



Step 9: Use hammer and pull bar to lock planks on final row.



MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES

MAINTAINING YOUR NEW FLOOR

Remember, like any floor covering, our factory finished floors will show signs of wear over time, depending on the size and lifestyle of your family. By observing a few precautions and setting up a regular cleaning routine and maintenance program, you can expect years of beauty from your floor.

- For general everyday cleaning, ordinary vacuuming or sweeping is usually sufficient. If needed, clean with
 a soft wet mop or moistened cloth ocassionally and not everyday. Always use clean water. Never flood
 the floor with water & never allow liquids to sit on the surface of the floor for longer durations. The
 vacuum head must be a brush or felt type. Be certain the wheels of the vacuum are clean and do not
 damage the finish. Do not use a vacuum with a beater bar head.
- For deep cleaning, use a mild shampoo with a soft sponge and scrub the floor gently. Then wipe the floor with a wet cloth to remove the residue and allow the floor to dry naturally. Deep cleaning should only be done once or twice a year.
- All spills should be cleaned up immediately. For tough spots, such as oil, paint drops, markers, ink, or tar, use a mild alcohol or nail polish remover with a clean cloth, then wipe the area immediately with a wet cloth to remove any remaining residue.
- Never use wax, polish or abrasive cleaners as they may dull or distort the finish. Don't use steel wool or scouring powder. Both can leave scratches on your floor.
- Avoid oil-based cleaners and products designed for wood floors. They can leave streaks that are impossible to remove. Never wax or polish Spc Flooring. Do not wash with harsh detergents or any other liquid cleaning aid. This could cause swelling, warping, joint line separation or other damage that may not be covered by our warranty.
- To avoid possible permanent indentation or surface damage, proper floor protection pads must be used under furniture & appliances.
- Do not drag any heavy items, furniture items, luggage or ladders, etc without proper protection which can cause scratches and damage to the flooring. Always cover your floor properly to avoid damage from other trade works such as painting, carpentry, plumbing, masonery, etc.
- Do not allow pets with unclipped nails to scratch or damage the floor.
- Use doormats and rugs in high traffic areas and pivot points (e.g., entry doors, stair landings, etc.), especially if you have a large family or indoor pets.
- Exposure to the sun and its UV rays causes dullness of the floor color. We recommend that you use
 drapes to minimize the exposure to direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time as warranties do not
 cover damage from UV exposure.
